WATCH IT !

With the best intentions in the world, over-zealousness on the part of a government can prove to be very wearisome.

Take the latest faux pas on the part of the Government of the United States of America.

The US Congress, recently, determined, in its wisdom, to federalize all screeners at airports in the US and on territories, under control of the US Government.
