HONGKONG SOLICITOR CONTINUES HIS LONG-RUNNING BATTLE WITH THE TAXMAN

It is not all that common that officers of the High Court of the Hongkong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China (PRC) are taken to task for allegedly, not paying their bills.

But it is becoming more and more common for some, it seems.

The latest, HKSAR solicitor to catch it in the neck, so to speak, is Mr Stephen Finley, who is shown, according to the records of The Law Society of Hongkong Ltd, as holding a Current Practising Certificate.

Mr Stephen Finley has just been sued by The Commissioner of Inland Revenue of Hongkong for \$HK374,325 in respect of alleged taxation matters, according to the records of **TOLFIN** (The Computerised Online Financial Intelligence Service and Web-Based, Credit-Checking Provider).

TOLFIN's records indicate that The Commissioner of Inland Revenue of Hongkong and Mr Stephen Finley have been at odds for some time, as the following 9 District Court Actions suggest:
