

HONGKONG TAXMAN TELLS BARRISTER GRAHAM ANTHONY HARRIS: I WANT MY TAX MONEY !

A leading barrister, practising in the Hongkong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China (PRC), has just been sued by The Commissioner for Inland Revenue of Hongkong for \$HK1,378,368.

This is the fifth time in the past 3 years that Barrister Graham Anthony Harris has been sued by The Commissioner for Inland Revenue of Hongkong.

According to the records of **TOLFIN** (The Computerised Online Financial Intelligence Service and Web-Based, Credit-Checking Provider), the following is the list of cases, lodged in the HKSAR District Court, naming Barrister Graham Anthony Harris as the lone Defendant:
