

OH ! TOM GROUP LTD: HOW COULD YOU ?

A subsidiary of TOM Group Ltd (TOM) (Code: 2383, Main Board, TMshe Stock Exchange of Hongkong Ltd), has been sued in the District Court of the Hongkong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China (PRC) for \$US111,120 (about \$HK866,736).

The subsidiary is China Entertainment Television Broadcast Ltd (), which, as at December 31, 2006, was 67.78 percent owned by TOM Group Ltd.

The Plaintiff in Action Number 1041 is Join Time Ltd (), a company, domiciled in the HKSAR, which is legally owned as to 96.67 percent by a Ms Pang Hoi Yin () and 3.33 percent by Ms Ng Yeuk Mui.

According to the database of **TOLFIN** () (The Computerised, Online Financial Intelligence Service and Web-Based, Credit-Checking Provider), the Registered Address of Join Time Ltd is:

The Statement of Claim, attached to Writ of Summons, Number 1041, alleges that China Entertainment Television Broadcast Ltd owes the Plaintiff \$US111,120 in respect of '*the balance of the license fees due under the following debit notes ...*'.

The purported debit notes date from January 31, 2007, until May 31, 2007.

It is alleged that the Plaintiff has been unable to obtain monies that are due and owing and, after sending repeated requests for payment, included a solicitor's letter, Join Time Ltd has resorted to asking the District Court to render a determination in this matter.

The Plaintiff is asking for \$US111,120 plus interest and costs of the Action.
