

### **THE CASE AGAINST SIMPSON MARINE LTD**

One of the oldest companies, operating in the Hongkong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China (PRC) in the sales of luxury yachts, has just been sued in the High Court of the territory.

The company is Simpson Marine Ltd which operates out of:

Unit Number 6, Ground Floor,  
Aberdeen Marine Tower,  
Number 8, Shum Wan Road,  
Aberdeen, Hongkong Island.

HKSAR High Court Action, Number 107, is between the Plaintiff, a person by the name of Mr Luan Gang of Chinachem Tower, 13<sup>th</sup> Floor, Numbers 34-37, Connaught Road, Central, Hongkong Island, and Simpson Marine Ltd.

The Writ of Summons does not have a Statement of Claim, attached to it, or even an Endorsement of Claim.

But, according to usually reliable sources, this is a dispute over a purported contract, allegedly signed between the Plaintiff and the Defendant in 2010.

According to the database of **TOLFIN** () (The Computerised, Online Financial Intelligence Service and Web-Based, Credit-Checking Provider), this is the third time since 1991 that Simpson Marine Ltd has been sued in the HKSAR High Court.

The other 2 cases were on October 11, 1991 – Kraft Wing Construction Company Ltd v. Simpson Marine Ltd, High Court Action, Number 7720 of 1991 – and July 1, 1992 – Mr Michael Brown v. Simpson Marine Ltd, High Court Action, Number 4375 of 1992.

The 1991 Action was for a claim of \$HK158,608.40 and the 1992 Action was for a claim in the amount of \$HK83,247.

Simpson Marine Ltd was incorporated in the HKSAR on October 13, 1981, when it was known as Charterboats Ltd. On October 23, 1987, this company's name was changed to Simpson Marine Ltd.
