YOUYUAN INTERNATIONAL HOLDINGS LTD: CAN THE CHAIRMAN RAISE \$HK556 MILLION IN ORDER TO HONOUR HIS PURPORTED FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS ?

This Is A Momma, Papa, And Nipper Company

Mr Ke Wen Tuo (), the Chairman of Youyuan International Holdings Ltd () (Code: 2268, Main Board, The Stock Exchange of Hongkong Ltd) has been sued twice in the past three weeks, both Writs of Summons, having been lodged in the High Court of the Hongkong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China (PRC).

Mr Ke Wen Tuo is the lone Defendant in Action Number 1894 of 2019 and the Third Defendant in Action Number 1824 of 2019.

The three Plaintiffs, in respect of the above-mentioned Writs of Summons, are claiming, in aggregate, about \$HK556 million, plus interest and costs of the legal actions.
