## \$HK620 MILLION- PLUS IS BEING CLAIMED FROM THE PRESENT CHAIRMAN AND MANAGING DIRECTOR AS WELL AS THE FORMER DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF PT INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION LTD

In The High Court of The Hongkong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of The People's Republic of China (PRC), Court of First Instance, in Action Number 1236 of 2024, four Plaintiffs have sought to claim damages in the amount of \$HK620 million-plus from the present Chairman and Managing Director as well as the former Deputy Chairman of PT International Development Corporation Ltd (保德國際發展企業有限公司) (Code: 372, Main Board, The Stock Exchange of Hongkong Ltd).

The four Plaintiffs with regard to this Action are:

## **THE INDORSEMENT OF CLAIM**

The Indorsement of Claim, attached to Writ of Summons, Number 1236 of 2024, lists the Plaintiffs' claims against the two Defendants as follows:

- '1. The Plaintiffs claim against the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Defendants for misrepresentation and/or conspiracy to injure and/or unlawful means conspiracy and seek damages for loss and damage in the amount of at least HK\$620,000,000.
- '2. In or about 2017, the Defendants induced and lured the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff into an alleged investment plan ("Alleged Investment Plan") whereby the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff would and did inject funds into his own special purpose vehicles ("SPVs") and thereafter to companies designated by the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant for the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff to invest in projects. Specifically, the Defendants represented to the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff:

- 2.1. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Defendants would introduce investment opportunities to the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff;
- 2.2. Subject to the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff's approval of the investment opportunity(ies) introduced by the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Defendants, the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff would inject funds into his SPVs and thereafter arrange for those SPVs to transfer the investment sum(s) according to payment instructions by the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant or his agent(s);
- 2.3. Upon the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff's payment of the investment sum(s), the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Defendants would act as the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff's agents in respect of such investment sum(s) and intermediary in any such investments undertaken by the 1<sup>st</sup> Plaintiff; and
- 2.4. In return, the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant would be entitled to 50% of any net profits derived from such investments introduced by the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Defendants upon divestment.
